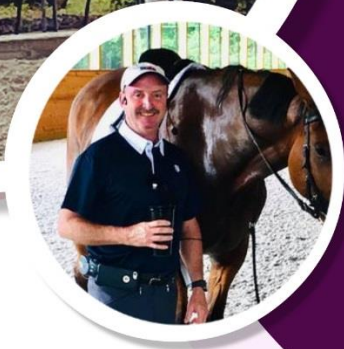

- Documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within 6 months of the clinic
- Signed release (see below)

LIABILITY RELEASE AND ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY

I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any VADA activities, including clinics, involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis & death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the VADA organizers and the facility (Stave Mill Farm); and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers ("Risks"). VADA MINUTES – ZOOM MEETING 3-17-2021

The meeting was called to order 8:00 at pm.

Sheli King made the motion to accept the minutes from the last meeting. Sherri Booye seconded, and the Board approved unanimously.

Treasurer's Report – Jessie has reported that are balances are around 145K.

2021 Williams/Warren Clinic: To be held June 26-27th. Rider applications are due electronically to Sheli by April 15th. She has received two so far. Selections will be made by one or both of the clinicians, Sheli, and Tina. All riders applying will be charged half of the fee plus a \$25 processing fee. If you are not chosen, the rider fee will be refunded but the \$25 processing fee will not. The \$25 can be used to cover one day of auditing. We will allow as many auditors as we can with COVID restrictions, and the live stream will be free for VADA members. VADA members will be charged \$25 for auditing which will include lunch. Non-VADA members will be charged \$40. VADA members will get priority. The live stream fee for non-VADA members will be \$10. Sheli does need volunteers so please contact her if you're interested. She particularly needs someone to co-ordinate auditing.

Chapter Challenge- Sandy Toby still needs reps for Fredricksburg and ShenVADA. The show will be held August 21st at The Meadow in Doswell. NE, Central, SVDA and ShenVADA also need to email Sandy with their special awards.

Conflict of Interest Policy- All VADA board members (eg chapter representatives) need to sign the policy and submit it to Alison.

DAL- To be held July 14-16. Opening date for entries is June 1 and closing date is July 5. Nancy Doody has already had some sponsorships secured but we still need more. Chapters please submit.

EHV-1 Oubreak- Tina recommends that chapters hosting any event require proof of the Flu-Rhino vaccination within six months of the date of the event. The FEI requires at least one week before but a board member who is a equine vets suggested two weeks. Effectiveness/timing may depend on whether it's a first vaccination or a booster.

Chapter Updates:

Central: April 10th Susan Carr Davis clinic at Saddlebrook in Powhatan, April 17th fix a test clinic with Kathy Rowse at Airfield in Wakefield, June 5th Saddle & Bit Fitting clinic with Anne Crowell at Oakdale in Powhatan and two day licensed show at Meadow Event Park in Doswell May 1-2

C'ville: Licensed show will be May 29th-30th opening date is April 10th. They are sanctioning the Bull Run show series and will be having a schooling show on March 27th.

NE: They are planning 4 Sunday and 4 evening schooling shows which will be USDF Regional Schooling Shows. They are also sanctioning the series that Marie Taylor is running in Wakefield.

NOVA: They are having a zoom based roundtable judges training on March 24th at 6:30. Participants are limited to judges, L grads, and L grad candidates. They will have a similar one in April which will be open to everyone. They are also planning a dressage camp the last week of July. They are planning their normal schedule of licensed and schooling shows and adding a midweek licensed show May 19th. Upcoming shows are March 20th (schooling) and April 9-10th (licensed) at Morven.

SE: They are having their normal schedule of schooling shows between March and October which will be USDF Regional Schooling Shows.

SW- They are having their educational Sunday on May 16th at Green Hill Park. Also they are having a two day clinic with Cody Armstrong-Pierce on August 28-29 at Green Hill Park.

ShenVADA- They are having two schooling shows- April 24th and then one in July.

Fred'burg- They have clinics planned for April, May and June or July. Their licensed show will be in September at Rosemont.

The meeting adjourned at 8:49 pm.

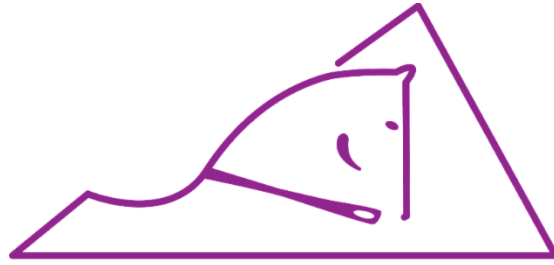
