#### VADA MINUTES – March 16, 2022 via Zoom

The meeting was called to order at 8:08 with representatives of all chapters except ShenVada.

**Participating:** Sheli King (VN); Sherri Booye (Charlottesville); Bettina Longaker (Charlottesville); Anne Draine (North East); Laura Nelson (Southwest); Alison Douglas (Central); Jessie Ginsburg (NOVA), Robyn Nunnally (SVDA); Karen Rice (Fred'burg); Lisa Beckwith (NEVADA); Nancy Lowey (C'ville); Nancy Doody (C'ville) and member Rachel Rice.

Laura Nelson made a motion to accept the January minutes, which was seconded by Alison Douglas and unanimously approved.

**Treasurer's Report** – Jessie reported that we have a combined balance of approximately \$168K. This reflects the income and expenses of the awards banquet, which was a loss of \$4900.

**Future of the Purple Book-** The board discussed the viability of either keeping the Purple Book or posting the information electronically on the website and updating as needed. Membership information could be sent out twice a year. Please discuss within your chapters and be ready to provide feedback to the board. The cost of producing and distributing the Purple Book is approximately \$4000 per year.

**DAL July 15-17-** Sheli reported that based on feedback from last year's show, we will have a mounted SHAC award ceremony. There will NOT be SHAC teams and PSG and Intermediate 1 will be split.

#### **Region 1 Championship Show-** Will be held October 6<sup>th</sup> thru 9<sup>th</sup>.

There was a question from a member regarding volunteer requirements and securing product for prizes. The board discussed and Nancy Doody will be gathering more information.

Note for Chapters and sponsorships for DAL and GAIG- there is a chapter bundle option available for \$200. Please support the shows.

**Schooling Shows listed in the Purple Book-** There was a question from a member whether these count for VADA year end awards. The answer is that ANY schooling show counts if it meets VADA requirements. They are listed in the Purple Book.

**2022 Youth Team Competition Sponsorship-** VADA is loaning our rings and a making a \$250 donation.

2023 Awards Banquet- Date will be Sunday, February 5<sup>th</sup>, 2023, at the Greencroft Club.

**Chapter Challenge-** Sheli led a discussion regarding whether we continue with the show or start another program to support the chapters. Each chapter is asked to recruit 1-2 members to stand on a committee which will bring feedback back to the board. Please submit names to Alison or Sheli.

**Other Business-** VHC is hosting a CDI and asked to use our rings. Sheli made a motion that we allow them to borrow our rings and make a \$500 donation. Sherri Booye seconded the motion and it passed unanimously. Also- note for chapters- please check the competition calendars on both USEF and the Region 1 Omnibus to make sure your website information and links to the show are correct. Conflict of Interest policy will be sent with the minutes. All board members are required to sign and return to Alison.

#### **Chapter Updates:**

**Central**- They will be having a Fix A Test on April 2<sup>nd</sup> with Carter Bass. Licensed shows April 30 and May 1. (two one day shows) **Fredericksburg** – They will be having a clinic on April 30<sup>th</sup> with Allison Spivey at Brookside Farm in Marshall. Their licensed show will be held at Rosemont in September.

**SVDA** – They are having a schooling show on March 27<sup>th</sup>. They are also running an online series "Know the Movement". **SWVADA**- They are having a schooling show on April 24<sup>th</sup>. Information can be found on their website.





- Stall decorating contest with prizes and other awards/contests will be held throughout the weekend.



The Virginia Horse Center Foundation Launches New Dressage Festival and CDI2\*

Lexington, VA.- The Virginia Horse Center Foundation (VHCF) is pleased to announce the inaugural **Mid-Atlantic Dressage Festival & Lexington CDI2\*** will take place at the Virginia Horse Center in Lexington, Virginia May 19 – May 22, 2022. The Festival will include both a national USEF licensed dressage competition and a new, international FEI CDI, or International Dressage Competition. The facility has hosted Lexington Spring Dressage, a national USEF licensed show which was successfully owned and managed by Rosinburg Events, LLC and Janine Malone from 2012 through 2021. Once Janine decided to scale-back her scope of operations to North Carolina, former VHC President of the Board, Gardy Bloemers, led the effort to have the VHC take on the national show and add a CDI. The competition will include the following FEI levels: CDI2\*, CDI1\*, CDIJ, CDIU25, CDICh, CDIAm, CDIP, CDIYH. Janine Malone will remain involved in these shows and stated: "I am so pleased that the Virginia Horse Center Foundation, with support from Gardy Bloemers, will expand the Lexington Spring Dressage show to include a CDI and grow it to attract more dressage competitors from throughout the eastern part of the U.S. It will be an exciting opportunity for all of the riders in our CDI divisions to get feedback from a panel of three judges".

The central location of the Virginia Horse Center, equidistant between Atlanta and NYC, provides much needed accessibility for those seeking competition experience at the CDI level.
