
DR121 Saddlery and Equipment:

- DR121.6: The upper cheek of a hanging cheek (baucher) snaffle (measured from the top of the mouthpiece to the top of the upper cheek) may not exceed seven centimeters.
- DR121.19: All competitors must complete check-in at the show office and receive a show number, before schooling or riding on the show grounds. Failure to check in at the show office prior to schooling will result in the issuance of a Warning Card.

VADA BOARD MEETING MINUTES 12-6-23 VIA ZOOM

Minutes: The minutes from the November meeting were approved by unanimous consent.

Treasurer's Report: Jessie reported that the combined balances are approximately \$204,000. We don't have the final numbers from GAIGs or any banquet expenses yet but the balance indicates we had a very successful show and that even with the loss from DAL, we will end the year in good shape.

Membership Report: Sheli doesn't have our final year end number yet. Note for chapters- please remind your members to join well in advance of their first show as there is a time lag between the date you join and when it finally gets to USDF.

2024 Clinic: Sheli brought up that the Youth Clinic we discussed at the last meeting is more tailored to FEI riders and doesn't serve the broad spectrum of our membership. She made the motion that in lieu of a clinic in 2024, we extend the additional \$400 for chapter grant article submissions by the chapters. Nancy Lowey seconded the motion and it passed unanimously. We will try to make it an online process for fluidity. We will proceed with a Lilo Fore clinic at Morven Park on the 3rd and 4th of May 2025.

Year End Banquet: The date is Sunday, February 4th at the Greencroft Club in Charlottesville. Nancy Doody continues to update membership on the deadlines via eblast. We are continuing with the same online procedures for checking year end award results. The review period is December 6th through 13th and any discrepancies should be sent to Joanne Collins. Once the list has been finalized, an email blast will be sent to the winners notifying them to go online and choose their awards. The volunteer hours for VIP will be online this year as well with Rachel Rice coordinating. Please encourage your chapter members to contribute to the silent auction.

Gafford Award: Laura Nelson is collecting the nominations and will send out a document with the submissions to the Chapters. Chapters then vote and send their choice back to Laura by January 19th. The winner will be recognized at the Awards Banquet.

2025 Election Committee: Nancy Lowey and Laura Nelson are soliciting nominations for the board positions. Please contact them if you are interested. The election will be held during the January board meeting.

USDF Convention Takeaways: Jessie, Sheli and Tina gave highlights of the various educational seminars and were very impressed and the quality of the speakers, most of whom were USDF members. Tina also spoke about the Safe Sport seminar, and we'll be discussing what the club should be doing proactively at a later date.
