The Virginia Dressage Association (VADA) will be hosting the "Great American Insurance Group/USDF Region 1 Dressage Championships and VADA Fall competition" on 8-11 October 2020, at the Virginia Horse Center, Lexington, VA. It will be under vastly different circumstances from the previous years. It will be the ultimate goal by the competition management to provide a safe environment for competitors, judges, volunteers, and staff by complying with COVID-19 protocols. VADA has made modifications aligned with USEF/USDF, State, and Virginia Horse Center guidelines for the October 2020 show format. There will be a limited number of vendors inside/outside with proper social distancing, an online show program, no spectators, wearing masks are required, and a limited hospitality venue. This is a great time for our clinic as weather will be cooler and we will be preparing for Championships and fall shows.

Our Clinician and Guest Speaker for our General Membership Meeting will be Lehua Custer, L Graduate with Distinction. The topic of our meeting will be: Overcoming Fears and Obstacles in Riding! This discussion will include active participation from the audience. Please be prepared to ask questions or share experiences if you so desire.

About Lehua:

Lehua worked and trained with the legendary Olympian, breeder, Judge and Trainer Hilda Gurney at Keenridge for 10 years, after being offered a job at her first lesson. During that time Lehua started countless horses, trained many up to FEI and she earned all of her USDF medals. Her incredible journey with FJ Ramzes began before he turned one and she has solely developed him. For the last two years, the talented pair trained with US Team Coach, Debbie McDonald, for preparation for international Grand Prix competition. She is currently riding with Ali Brock with hopes to represent the US in the very near future. This team is certainly one to watch and even Carl Hester mentioned he'd want to have FI Ramzes in his barn!

Lehua teaches students of all levels and ages with a special interest in helping riders ride their own horse up the levels and push past any mental barriers. She truly has a "you can do it!" optimism. Her students have enjoyed many successes to include Regional Championship victories! Lehua particularly enjoys the experience of training non-traditional breeds to FEI. Lehua competed at National competitions in both Dressage and in Arabian breed divisions. A horse she purchased one day after birth, is now a licensed stallion and won the 2019 3-year old Colts and Geldings class at Dressage at Devon. The pair was invited to the USDF Young Horse Prospect Forum in 2020 and were extremely well received. This exciting duo is set to take the Young Horse classes by storm!





More information on why SVDA need your Coggins

This month I am revisiting an article I penned a couple of years ago about the report SVDA is required to submit to the Virginia Department of Agriculture & Consumer Services (VACS) confirming that all horses participating in our events have a current negative Equine Infectious Anemia test, commonly known as a Coggins test, on file with us. Please remember that if you bring a non-participating horse, companion horse, or a horse you're getting acclimated to traveling and the new experience of shows, SVDA needs a copy of their Coggins as well. The barns where we hold our shows and clinics are counting on SVDA to ensure that <u>all</u> horses coming onto their property for our shows have a negative Coggins.

We have had a few horses whose Coggins lists someone as the owner other than the person we know is the owner. When I submit the report to the state, we have to list whoever is notated as the owner on the Coggins as the owner. Sometimes the state follows up and checks these reports against what's on file and they have the authority to come to an event and require us to produce the Coggins for all the horses our show participants bring onto the barn property.

As an aside, if you trail ride on state property/parks Virginia VACS or park officials can require you to present your horse's Coggins. They will accept an electronic copy so it might be good to upload that to your smart phone. Here's what the state says: "Horse owners do not need to carry the certificate with them while riding. They can keep the certificate in their vehicle or trailer, but owners may be required to produce one for a parks official, and having it on hand may avoid potential inconveniences."

Also, the name of the horse on the entry should match the name on the Coggins. The Coggins form has multiple fields for the horse's name, i.e. registered name, barn name, etc. Please ensure that your vet has all your horse's names and that they are all entered on the Coggins. This is helpful to SVDA and to VACS.

When you get your new Coggins please take a few minutes and upload it to the SVDA database through the portal on our website. Go to http://southeastvirginiadressage.org/home/ place your cursor on More on the top menu and a drop down menu will appear, click on Shows, under Schooling Show Forms click on Upload your Coggins Here, fill out the information and use the browse button to find your Coggins certificate on your computer, enter it and then click submit and you're all done. If you find this confusing or have problems, do not hesitate to contact me (penlandr@cox.net or 757-965-6349) and I will try to provide clear, and hopefully, intelligent help.

I hope you find this informative and it answers any questions you might have. Below is the Virginia regulation:


2VAC5-70-20. Testing Requirements for Horses Exhibited at Shows, Fairs, or Other Exhibitions, or Coming into Contact with Horses Owned by Others in Virginia.

All horses assembled at a show, fair, race meet, or other such function, or participating in any activity on properties where horses belonging to different owners may come into contact with each other in Virginia, must be accompanied by a report of an official negative test for equine infectious anemia. The test shall be conducted by an approved laboratory on a sample taken by an accredited veterinarian or a State-Federal Regulatory Veterinarian within 365 days prior to such event or activity. The person in charge will ensure that a copy of the official negative test results accompanies each horse in the event or activity, and shall make such reports available for inspection by a representative of the State Veterinarian upon request. The person in charge shall exclude any horse which is not accompanied by a negative test report.


