ATTENTION VOLUNTEERS:

SVDA Volunteer of the Day Program

In addition to receiving volunteer hours for volunteering at a show, SVDA is implementing a Volunteer of the Day program at schooling shows. All volunteers' names will be placed in a hat (one time for half day volunteers, two times for whole day volunteers) and one name will be randomly drawn. The winner can select their choice from a variety of gifts and gift cards, each with a \$25 value. Available choices are gift cards from Chick-fil-A, Wawa, Starbucks, SmartPak, Sugar Shack at the Mingle, and a gift bag from Cypress Saddlery. SVDA SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM:

Each year, SVDA members are eligible to apply for Scholarship and Foundation funds to further their advancement in dressage.

The SVDA Board of Directors votes on the applications received and can award up to two (2) Scholarships in the amount of \$400. If less than two (2) scholarships are given out in one (1) year, or there are additional funds, the Board may vote to give out additional scholarships that year.

VADA BOARD MEETING MINUTES 3-04-25 VIA ZOOM

Minutes: The minutes of the January meeting were approved unanimously.

Treasurer's Report: The combined balances are 225K. The financial report from the banquet was discussed. It was a net expense of 8K. The reservation and silent auction income were just shy of covering the facility expense which is always our goal.

Membership Report: For the year 2025, we have 360 memberships submitted.

Lilo Fore Clinic: It will be held May 3-4 at Morven Park. The rider applications are on the website, and we are not looking at the applications until the closing date to get proper representation between levels and chapters. The application deadline has been extended to March 15th. We currently have 12 applications of varying levels, but they are all from NOVA or C'ville chapters, so we'd love to have more of a representation of all chapters. We have a fair number of auditors signed up and the Friday judges session is filling. We need volunteers- need someone for Friday from 2-8 and then also someone for all day Sunday. Anyone interested please contact Sheli.

Zoom Education Session: Rachel is hoping to put together a lecture by Gwen Ka'awaloa focused on providing first aid with items typically already available at your barn. She will provide more information when she has an update.

VADA Safe Sport Initiative: We have a committee made up of a representative from each chapter. Sheli will be scheduling a meeting. There are two parts – the chapters' adoption of MAAP which they should start discussing how to implement, and the requirement for all VADA members who are involved in activities where they can reasonably be expected to come into contact with minors to take safe sport training. The committee will look at how this requirement can be implemented and tracked and what kind of guidance VADA can provide to its chapters.

Donation to the VHC: Sheli asked for input from them and at the \$20K level were improvements to the show office. The board discussed the amount and the fact that we have not donated since 2020. We took into consideration that a donation of 20K this year would be the same as having donated 5K per year for the last four years. Jessie made a motion to make the \$20K donation earmarked for show office improvements, it was seconded by Tina and passed unanimously.

GAIG/DAL Update: Dianne via email reported that officials are hired, and hotels are in place. We are hosting three judges apprentice programs. We will have a small R at DAL and a R apprentice and L testing at GAIGs.

New Business: Laura Nelson brought up that they have two club members who compete and are blind. They rely on the living letters around the ring which currently number 12. She heard of a proposed rule change that would take that down to four. Sheli asked Laura to send her the information she had, and she'd look into it.
