

F15- BRED IN SOUTHEAST VIRGINIA AWARD

1. The "Bred in Southeast Virginia Award" was submitted by a board committee and was motioned, seconded and passed 21 April 2014 and is to be awarded annually to the horse with the highest average of 3 scores at schooling shows, licensed shows, or a combination of those. A copy of the front of the tests or the USDF printout must be included with the award application form.
2. Scores from musical freestyles, opportunity classes or rider tests are not eligible
3. Horse must have been bred in southeastern Virginia (as defined in the VADA Purplebook): Norfolk, Portsmouth, Virginia Beach, Chesapeake, Suffolk, Hampton, Newport News, Williamsburg, Gloucester, Isle of Wright. A copy of the registration papers or other documentation to this effect must be included with the award form. ("Bred" means the mare owner or stallion owner lives in SE Virginia)
4. Applicant must be a current SVDA member in good standing with at least 8 hours of volunteer credit in the award year (four of which must be completed by July 1).
5. Horse need not be competing in the SVDA area5. The award form must be completed and submitted to the Awards Chairman with the appropriate documentation
6. This award is limited to once per horse per level. A horse may win at different levels. This is to "promote" up the level achievements.
